

JUNIUS TOWN BOARD
PUBLIC HEARING
REGULAR MEETING
APRIL 17, 2013

ATTENDANCE: RONALD SERVEN, SUPERVISOR
COUNCILMAN: JOHN YANNOTTI, JEROME MARSHALL, C.ERNEST BROWNELL
ABSENT: COUNCILMAN TODD MERKLEY

OPEN: SUPERVISOR SERVEN OPENED THE PUBLIC HEARING ON A RESOLUTION TO INTRODUCE LOCAL LAW 1 OF THE YEAR 2013 AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE BEST VALUE STANDARD AT 7:10P.M.BY LEADING WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. THE TOWN CLERK VERIFIED THE PUBLIC NOTICE WAS IN THE PAPER. THE FLOOR WAS OPENED AND THERE WASN'T ANY COMMENTS.

ADJOURN: SUPERVISOR SERVEN ADJOURNED THE PUBLIC HEARING AT 7:12P.M AFTER A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL IN FAVOR AND THE PUBLIC HEARING WAS CLOSED AT 7:12 P.M.

REGULAR MEETING: THE REGULAR MEETING STARTED AT 7:12P.M. WITH THE SAME MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE. THERE WERE 16 MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ALSO THERE.

TOWN CLERK: THE TOWN CLERK PASSED OUT A NOTICE THAT SHE RECEIVED FROM THE D.E.C. EXPLAINING HOW THE D.E.C WILL BE CHANGING THEIR SOFTWARE VENDOR AND TAKING BACK ALL THE STATE OWNED EQUIPMENT. WHICH MEANS THE TOWN WILL NOW HAVE TO SUPPLY THEIR OWN COMPUTORS AND PRINTERS TO WORK WITH THE NEW SOFTWARE. A MOTION TO HAVE A RESOLUTION TO OPT OUT OF SELLING SPORTING AND FISHING LICENCES WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL. ALL MEMBERS WERE IN FAVOR OF THE RESOLUTION. THE TOWN CLERK WILL NOTIFY THE D.E.C.

MINUTES: COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT LAST MONTHS MINUTES AS WRITTEN AND COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI MADE THE SECOND. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. THE TOWN CLERK READ HER MONTHLY REPORT SHOWING A TOTAL OF \$54.00 AND THE TOWN SHARE WAS \$48.00. COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AND WITH COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

WATER: THE TOTAL OUTSTANDING IN THE MONTHS OF JANUARY, FEBRUARY AND MARCH 2013 IN DISTRICT 1 WAS \$18,230.70 AND IN DISTRICT 2 IT WAS \$4,490.43. COUNCILMAN MARSHALL MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AND COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI SECONDED. THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

SEWER: FRED WITT HAS SPOKEN WITH BARB CARR AT THE SENECA COUNTY MANAGERS OFFICE. HE WILL BE SENDING BLUE PRINTS AND OTHER REPORTS SHE HAS REQUESTED.

HIGHWAY: CHIPS MONEY HAS BEEN PRO-RATED AND THIS YEAR THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WILL BE RECEIVING \$95,539.00. THE DEAPRTMENT HAS BEEN CLEANING DITCHES; STUMP GRINDING AND GETTING READY FOR SPRING CLEAN UP DAY. COUNCILMAN MARSHALL MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE HIGHWAY REPORT AND COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MADE THE SECOND. THE MOTION WAS PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

WATER: A NEW CONTRACT IS NEEDED FOR THE TOWN OF TYRE. COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MOTION TO KEEP THE TERMS ALREADY SET AND WITH COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI MAKING THE SECOND THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. ALSO THERE WAS A DISCUSSION ABOUT HOOKING UP THE NEW TEA HOUSE TO THE WATER DISTRICT.

ASSESSOR: THE ASSESSOR HANDED IN HIS WRITTEN REPORT. THERE WAS A BREIF DISCUSSION REGARDING FINGER LAKES TECHNOLOGIES GROUP AND VERIZON PROPERTIES IN TOWN. THE TOTAL ASSESSMENT FOR BOTH PARCELS IS \$191,884.00. COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AND WITH COUNCILMAN MARSHALL MAKING THE SECOND THE MOTION PASSED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

COMMITTEE: A COMMITTEE WILL BE SET UP TO INITIATE A NEW LOCAL LAW REGARDING THE RIGHT TO FARM. COUNCILMAN JEROME MARSHALL WILL CHAIR THE COMMITTEE. COUNCILMAN BROWNELL, AND PLANNING BOARD MEMBERS TOM HICKS AND BOB STEVENS WILL ALSO BE ON THE COMMITTEE.

OLD BUSINESS: BEFORE THE LOCAL LAW 1 FOR BEST VALUE CAN CONTINUE ATTORNEY FOR THE TOWN MICHAEL MIRRAS REQUESTED THAT THE PROPOSED LAW IS SENT TO THE SENECA COUNTY PLANNING BOARD FOR COMMENT. THE TOWN CLERK WILL MAIL IT OUT. THE DISCUSSION FOR COMBINING THE TOWN TAX COLLECTOR AND THE TOWN CLERK OFFICES WAS TABLED.

NEW BUSINESS: JOHN DENDIS SPOKE ABOUT HAVING THE TERMS FOR THE TOWN SUPERVISOR AND THE TOWN SUPERINTENDANT EXTENDED TO A FOUR YEAR TERM INSTEAD OF A TWO YEAR TERM. PAT PANECK AND LOLA STONE BROUGHT THEIR CONCERNS TO THE BOARD REGARDING A LOOSE DOG ON BIRDSEY ROAD. THE STANDARD WORK DAY RESOLUTION FOR NYS RETIREMENT SYSTEM WAS MOTION TO ACCEPT BY COUNCILMAN MARSHALL AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. THERE WAS A BRIEF DISCUSSION FOR GETTING A SIGN FOR THE TOWN HALL.

BILLS: A MOTION FROM COUNCILMAN BROWNELL TO TRANSFER \$39,024.47 FROM THE HIGHWAY RESERVE FUND TO THE HIGHWAY FUND WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN MARSHALL AND ALL MEMBERS WERE IN FAVOR.

GENERAL FUND V#65-90 FOR \$41,353.72 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

HIGHWAY FUND V#26-38 FOR \$76,508.78 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN MARSHALL AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

WATER 1 FUND V#27-36 FOR \$18,796.03 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

SEWER FUND V#47-64 FOR \$4,342.79 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN MARSHALL. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

WATER 2 FUND V#14-15 FOR \$325.00 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN MARSHALL AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

ADJOURN: MOTION TO ADJOURN THE MEETING AT 8:05P.M WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN MARSHALL AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN YANNOTTI. ALL MEMBERS WERE IN FAVOR AND THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED.
