JUNIUS TOWN BOARD  
JUNIUS TOWN HALL  
REGULAR MEETING

ATTENDANCE: SUPERVISOR GREG WADHAMS, COUNCILMEN DAVIS, BROWNELL, R. WADHAMS AND JAMES PATSOS. ATTORNEY FOR THE TOWN MICHAEL MIRRAS

OPEN: THE SUPERVISOR OPENED TONIGHT'S MEETING AT 7:00 WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLIANCE.  
TOWN CLERK: THE TOWN CLERKS MINUTES WERE MOTION FOR APPROVAL BY COUNCILMAN BROWNELL, AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. THE TOWN CLERKS REPORT SHOWED A TOTAL DISBURSEMENT OF \$440.00 WITH THE TOWN SHARE OF \$355.00. COUNCILMAN DAVIS MADE THE MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AND WITH COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR. ALSO ON JULY 5, 2017 THE TOWN CLERK RECEIVED AND HANDED OVER A SENECA COUNTY CHECK #1437 FOR \$6000.00 RESOLUTION 126-17 TO THE SUPERVISOR'S OFFICE.

WATER: COUNCILMAN BROWNELL REPORTED THAT SOME OF THE OTHER TOWNS IN THE NEW PROPOSED WATER DISTRICT ARE NOW SEEKING BIDS TO DO THEIR PART OF THE DISTRICT. THE ATTORNEY FOR THE TOWN STATED THAT THERE NEEDS TO BE SOME CLARIFICATION TO THE COMPTROLLER IN THE TOTAL FINAL COST FOR THIS TOWN BEFORE THEY CAN CONTINUE.

SEWER: THE PLANT IS RUNNING WELL. BLUE HERON VISTED THE PLANT FOR POSSIBLE BID ON THE DEMO OF THE PLANT. RL STONE CAME IN TO DO THEIR YEARLY CALIBRATION.

BUILDING: WHILE THE DOOR TO THE TOWN HALL IS HERE, IT HAS YET TO BE INSTALLED. DISANTOS HAS NOT RETURNED COUNCILMAN DAVIS CALL AS OF YET.

OLD BUSINESS: THERE SEEMS TO BE A QUESTION ON SOME FIGURES THE COMPTROLLER NEEDED TO CONTINUE WITH THE NEW WATER DISTRICT. THE BOARD WILL LOOK INTO THE ACTUAL AMOUNTS FOR THE COMPTROLLER. POSSIBLY THE FIGURES ARE BEFORE/AFTER THE GRANT. COUNCILMAN WADHAMS STARTED THE DISCUSSION ON GETTING PART TIME HELP IN THE SUPERVISORS OFFICE FOR ENTERING BACK DATA ONLY. IN THE MIDDLE OF THIS DISCUSSION COUNCILMAN BROWNELL WANTED TO GO ON RECORD TO STATE THAT HE REFUSED SIGNING THE CHECKS TONIGHT STATING THAT WAS THE ADVICE FROM THE COMPTROLLER.

COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MADE THE MOTION TO HIRE PAUL WAGNER AT HIS PROPOSED RATE OF \$70.00 AN HOUR PLUS TRAVEL, TO TRAIN THE NEW SUPERVISOR'S CLERK WITH RECORDING OF BACK DATA. ALSO TO HIRE DENISE DARCANGELIS TO RECORD SAID DATA AT \$16.00 AN HOUR AND EXTRA FILING ABOVE THE NORMAL DUTIES. COUNCILMAN PATSOS MADE THE SECOND, WHICH CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

NEW BUSINESS: THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO PREPARED A NEW WATER AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES FOR THE BENEFIT OF JUNIUS WATER DISTRICT NOS. 1 AND 2. ALSO PREPARED WAS A NEW AGREEMENT PROVISION OF WATER SUPPLY SUPPORT SERVICES JUNIUS WATER SUPPLY SUPPORT SERVICES JUNIUS WATER DISTRICT NOS. 1 AND 2. THE ATTORNEY FOR THE TOWN WENT OVER BOTH THE OLD AND NEW AGREEMENT. THERE IS A CHANGE IN THE EMPLOYEE PAY THAT IS MAKING THE EXTRA COST. COUNCILMAN WADHAMS MADE THE MOTION TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN SUPERVISOR TO SIGN THE

AGREEMENTS AND WITH COUNCILMAN PATSOS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

BILLS: THE ABSTRACTS WERE READ BY THE SUPERVISOR CLERK.

GENERAL FUND V# 128-151 FOR \$50,547.25 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN PATSOS AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN WADHAMS. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

HIGHWAY FUND V#46-48 FOR \$1,567.15 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN WADHAMS AND THE SECOND MADE BY COUNCILMAN DAVIS, WHICH CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

WATER1 FUND V#29-31 FOR \$6,591.93 WAS MOTION TO PAY BY COUNCILMAN PATSOS AND THE SECOND CAME FROM COUNCILMAN WADHAMS. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.

ADJOURN: COUNCILMAN PATSOS MADE THE MOTION TO ADJOURN TONIGHT'S MEETING AT 8:10P.M. AND WITH COUNCILMAN DAVIS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.
