PUBLIC BUDGET HEARING
JUNIUS TOWN HALL

ATTENDANCE: SUPERVISOR WADHAMS, COUNCILMAN DAVIS, COUNCILMAN BROWNELL, COUNCILMAN WADHAMS, COUNCILMAN PATSOS.

OTHERS: MICHAEL MIRRAS, ATTORNEY FOR THE TOWN AND PHIL GRISWOLD, ASSESSOR FOR THE TOWN.

OPEN: COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MADE THE MOTION AT 7:07 TO OPEN THE BUDGET HEARING, AND WITH COUNCILMAN PATSOS MAKING THE SECOND, THE HEARING WAS OPEN. SUPERVISOR WADHAMS STARTED WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

QUESTIONS: THERE WASN'T TOO MANY QUESTIONS AS NO ONE THE PUBLIC ATTEND THE HEARING. A FEW THINGS WERE MENTIONED BY PHIL GRISWOLD TO HELP CUT BACK SOME OF THE BUDGETS. SOME THINGS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE BUDGET AS THOSE POSITIONS ARE NO LONGER IN THE TOWN. SUPERINTENDANT FISK HAD MENTIONED IN A WORKSHOP EARLIER THAT HE BELIEVES HE CAN MAINTAIN THE SAME BUDGET AS LAST'S YEARS. ALSO THE JUDGES, TOWN CLERK AND THE PLANNING BOARD DID THE SAME. THE ASSESSOR HAD SAID THE SAME THING, AND DID NOT WANT A RAISE, SO HIS SALARY WILL REMAIN THE SAME.

ADJOURN: COUNCILMAN BROWNELL MADE THE MOTION TO ADJOURN AT 7:45 AND WITH COUNCILMAN PATSOS MAKING THE SECOND, THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED WITH ALL MEMBERS IN FAVOR.
